“They told the few of us that were there that clearly we were there by design,” he shared. “I had a chance to talk to pretty much all the coaches and they basically told me to keep in touch and said, ‘If we didn’t want you, we wouldn’t have had you come up here.’”

The Chancellor standout helped lead the Chargers to an 8-3 record this past season. Despite coming up a bit short in the playoffs, the talented lineman seemed to dominate his competition all year long.

“I thought I had a pretty good overall season,” claimed Moss. “I didn’t give up any sacks last year and that was my personal goal. I just like running people down the field and then running them into the ground. I really do love run blocking.”

With already a great list of collegiate offers in the fold, the Virginia product has already begun to decide what he’ll be looking for when he starts comparing universities.

“I’m going to be looking for a college that focuses on academics,” he explained. “They’ll have to also have my major, but I’m not sure what I want to major in yet. I’m also going to be looking at whether they have a program that’s on the rise and what type of coaching staff they have.”
