“I really want my mom and my brother to finally see it,” he said. “Me and my dad are already in love with it, but I really want my mom and my brother to experience it firsthand.”

Trumbetti has had Notre Dame as his clear leader since picking up that offer last summer and that remains unchanged. He also has offers from schools like Boston College, Maryland, Michigan State, Purdue, Rutgers and Virginia and is receiving serious interest from other schools as well.

He isn't in a rush to make a decision and has plans to check out other schools in the coming months as well.

“I'm going to Florida, Penn State, Maryland, Miami, Alabama probably,” he said. “Florida, Miami and Penn State will be before I go to Notre Dame. That'll be my first time for all of them.”

Trumbetti would also like the chance to get out to Stanford at some point.

He may not have a timeline for a decision, but couldn't help but think forward on National Signing Day for the Class of 2013.
